

## SPRONGS BLUFF LANDOWNERS' ASSOCIATION DUMPSTER AND RECYCLING

---

The dumpster and the recycling totes are located on the south side of the big pole barn on Sprongs Bluff Drive.

From Memorial Day through Labor Day, the dumpster is serviced weekly, very early on Thursday mornings. Recycling is picked up every other week very early on Monday mornings.

After Labor Day and until Memorial Day, dumpster and totes are emptied once every two weeks, very early on Thursday and Monday mornings, respectively.

To operate dumpster, open any flap and throw stuff inside. Close flap.

To operate a tote, lift lid and place stuff inside. Lower lid.

Do NOT climb into dumpster. There is a good reason your neighbor divested that shiny object.

It never does any good to ask taller people to use the dumpster's top flaps, leaving capacity behind the front angled flaps for folks less tall to access easily from the ground. So I won't mention that here.

### DUMPSTER:

The Sprongs Bluff Community maintains an annual contract for a dumpster and recycling totes with Town and Country Disposal, a subsidiary of Youngblood Disposal.

Residents who intend to utilize the dumpster and/or recycling totes are asked to pay in advance a lump sum, in 2018–2019 \$6 per month of planned usage, from inception and through the SBLOA fiscal year, which runs from July 1 through June 30. The Town of Sodus informally allows us to maintain the dumpster and totes on Town of Sodus property. We are expected to keep the site in well-ordered condition.

The dumpster is intended only for household garbage and trash.  
The dumpster is not intended for construction/remodeling debris.

*The following items may not be placed in or around the dumpster:*

- Automobile tires and rims
- Automotive oil or ATF fluid (empty, dry containers are OK)
- Batteries of any type
- Paint or other chemicals (empty, dry containers are OK)
- Electronics (see below under ‘DO NOT RECYCLE’)
- Couches, mattresses, refrigerators, and the like. Please see Page 6 for a schedule of Town and Country/Youngblood fees for picking up couches, mattresses, refrigerators, and the like ‘curbside’ at your property.

All of the above bulleted items, except for electronics, may be taken to Alpcore Recycling in Macedon: <http://www.alpcorecycling.com/> 315–986–8900.

The Town of Sodus may take some of the above items (but not electronics) during the bi-annual public access days at the Town Dump. Call Town Clerk Lori Diver at 315–483–6934 for current information.

### RECYCLING:

Recyclable materials (e.g. paper, glass, plastic, metal) may be mixed together. Please place the following CLEAN and EMPTY items in the recycling totes.

#### Paper

- Bulk mailings
- books
- phone books
- newspapers
- inserts
- magazines
- catalogues
- office paper
- file folders
- paper bags

#### Boxes

- food/drink/soup/shipping boxes, pizza boxes
- gable-top cartons
- paper towel rolls, etc.

#### Cardboard/Cartons (flatten all boxes)

#### Plastic bottles and containers #1–7 (Caps may remain attached.)

#### Glass jars and bottles (Caps may remain attached.)

#### Metal

- metal pots and pans
- foil
- pie tins
- license plates
- aluminum
- tin
- steel
- aerosol cans

### DO NOT RECYCLE:

- garbage
- ceramics
- Styrofoam
- dishes or glassware
- food waste
- plastic bags
- hazardous waste containers
- light bulbs, window glass or mirrors
- electrical cords, hoses or ropes
- syringes/sharps
- yard waste
- Electronics (TV's, computers, microwaves, Star Trek Teleportation Terminals, etc.)
  - As of January 1, 2015, NYS DEC requires special handling:

  - Town and Country no longer handles electronics. Each Resident is responsible for disposal of our own electronics.
  - Maven Technologies in Rochester is apparently a useful one-stop solution. Maven claims to wipe computer hard drives and memory clean, as a security measure. Visit:

  - Googling may yield other alternatives, as this landscape gradually adjusts to the relatively new DEC ban.

**SOME SCRAP METAL:** On July 17, 2018, SBLOA President David Fitch provided the following info to the Membership: "...a plastic apple crate has been placed behind the recycling bins for metal recycling only–no trash. We have an outside contractor who will pick up the scrap metal on a routine basis. He will take some appliances but check with Bill Smith <callbill1@yahoo.com> on questionable items such as refrigerators. Metal items such as outdoor grills, chairs, and washing machines are acceptable. Please no plastic or wood items in the crate."

### **CURBSIDE PICKUP :**

Please see Page 6 for a Schedule of Town and Country's fees *for occasional 'curbside pickup' of large household items* roadside from your property. The fees are steep. If your item contains substantial metal (e.g. a refrigerator or stove) an informal arrangement, at no cost to you, may be possible ad hoc with a Sodus resident who deals in scrap. To arrange curbside pickup by Town and Country Disposal, please call 585-254-7081 to describe your items and to prepay over the phone for guaranteed pickup within two business days. Ask for the Commercial Account Supervisor, Malory Bridges.

Malory has agreed to help save wear and tear on our road by honoring (when possible) individual requests that their 12-foot (U-Haul sized) truck be sent into our community for curbside pickups, rather than the big dumpster truck. Please do request this when describing your item(s), to see if feasible.

In the Schedule of Fees on Page 6, the header, "All Companies," simply refers to all of the several Disposal Companies owned by Youngblood.
