Boxes

- food/drink/soup/shipping boxes, pizza boxes
- gable-top cartons
- paper towel rolls, etc.

Cardboard/Cartons (flatten all boxes)

Plastic bottles and containers #1-7 (Lids may remain attached.)

Glass jars and bottles (Lids may remain attached.)

Metal

- metal pots and pans
- foil
- pie tins
- license plates
- aluminum
- tin
- steel
- aerosol cans

Don't Recycle These:

- Electronics (TV's, computers, etc.)
